How to Apply

The work of prospective artists is voted on by current full members during the General Meeting held the first Tuesday of the month. Call Lorraine Nuzzo, gallery manager (631) 549-5106 to arrange a date to bring in the work prior to the General Meeting.

- ◆ 4-6 jpg images of additional work (if available) email to manager@bjspokegallery.com
- ◆ curricula vitae/artist resume
- ◆ artist statement or a brief description of your work

Membership Voting

The work, resume, and artists statement is reviewed by gallery member artists, and a vote is taken on the merit of the work. You will be notified of result within 7 days and a day will be arranged for you to pick up your work. If an artist's work is not accepted it is recommended that they resubmit at a later time.

Artists whose work is accepted should schedule a meeting with Lorraine Nuzzo, gallery manager. At that time, the artist will be given a contract and the monthly dues are to be paid. Any questions about the gallery and membership benefits will be answered during that meeting. New members are trained by the gallery manager in general gallery management and sales procedures. Full members sit once a month, if the new member chooses not to sit, the gallery manager or the gallery president can sit in your place for a fee of \$50.
